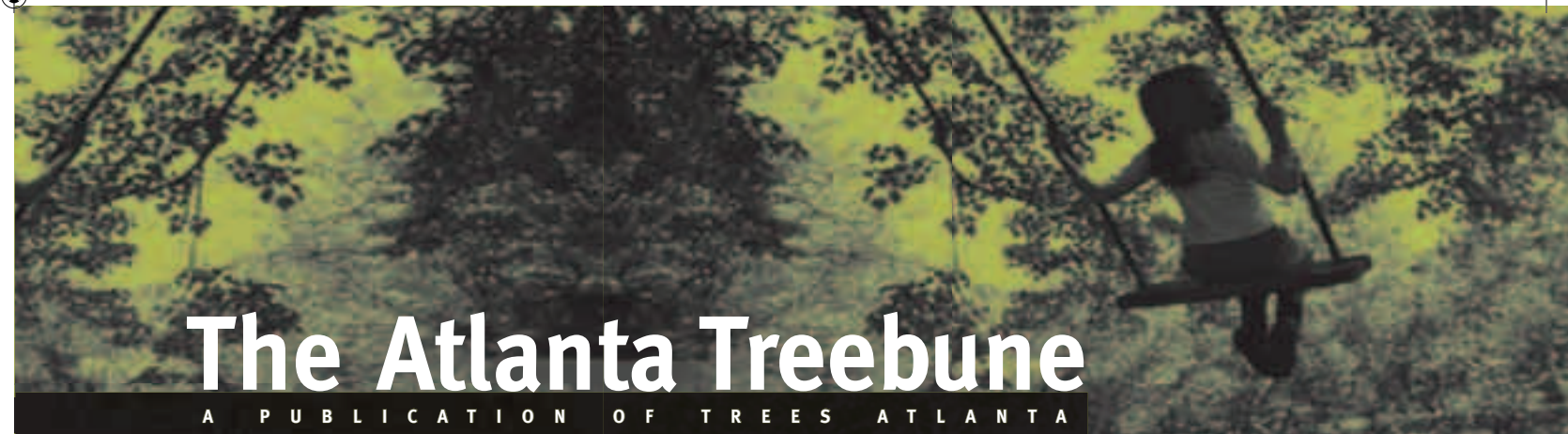
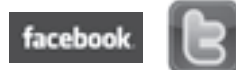

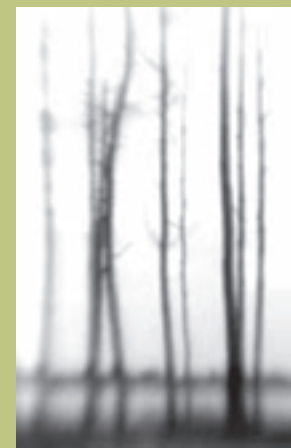

EVERYONE is invited to Trees Atlanta headquarters on October 9th for the best tree sale of the decade! In celebration of our 25th anniversary, this year's Trees Atlanta Tree Sale will feature over 1,000 native and unusual trees and plants and offer 25 species and varieties of trees, shrubs, and forest-safe vines never before offered at previous tree sales.

Special trees include bladdernut, butternut, weeping forest pansy redbud, Emerald Knight fringe tree, 'Invincible Spirit' hydrangea, and Devil's Walking Stick. Non-invasive, unusual/exotic tree and plant varieties include Henry's Dwarf, Parrotia, Colossus Oyama magnolia, Halka Ginkgo and Arnold's Promise witch hazel.

Five Star Grant for Clear Creek Restoration

The National Fish and Wildlife Foundation awarded Trees Atlanta a Five Star Grant to restore the Clear Creek streambank between Ansley Square and Ansley Mall along the Atlanta BeltLine Arboretum. This high-visibility project is an addition to Piedmont Park's restoration project further upstream.

13-miles of Trees Inventoried

In partnership with BeltLine Inc., Trees Atlanta is near completion of 13 miles of tree inventory in the Atlanta BeltLine corridor, checking and tagging each tree with GPS coordinates. The inventory will help designers protect specimens, woodlands and select species, measure recompense and identify invasive plants.

1st BeltLine Sculpture installed

The David Landis Sculpture *Cycles* (right) was installed in late May. Funded by the Arthur M. Blank Foundation, the stainless whirling ginkgo stands nearly 20 feet tall and represents the Warehouse Row Natural Neighborhood of the Atlanta BeltLine Arboretum. The ginkgo tree is one of the symbolic trees of this Natural Neighborhood. There are 7 varieties of Ginkgo planted here!

Audubon's Arboretum Pamphlets Available

Trees Atlanta partner Audubon has completed all 14 Natural Neighborhood educational pamphlets for the BeltLine Arboretum. The pamphlets are available at the Trees Atlanta Kendeda Center and describe each Natural Neighborhood, its symbolic trees, trees relationships to wildlife and its symbolic bird.
