



Corporate Volunteer Tree Planting Program

Through Trees Atlanta's Corporate Volunteer Program, employees have an opportunity to lend a hand and help make Atlanta a cleaner, greener, more inviting place to live and work. Whether planting trees along a city street or mulching and pruning in a city park, volunteers get a real sense of accomplishment and enjoy a change of pace from their ordinary workday. Trees Atlanta Corporate Volunteer projects are also a great way to reduce carbon footprinting and give back to the Atlanta community.

Trees Atlanta requests a donation from each corporation for its project. Funds not only provide necessary supplies, materials and tools for each event, but also ensure that the work Trees Atlanta does in neighborhoods throughout Atlanta can continue beyond each volunteer day. All donations are tax-deductible.

If you are unable to provide a donation but are interested in helping out, we will try to accommodate your employees at an already scheduled NeighborWoods project, which occur primarily on Saturdays.

Tree Planting Project- suggested donation-\$1,500 + \$180/tree planted (available October-March)

1. A weekday employee volunteer tree planting project for up to 50 participants
2. We recommend planting no more than 1 tree per participant
3. Publicity photographs taken at event that will appear on the "I Dig Trees" page of the Trees Atlanta website
4. Company logo on neighborhood tree tags with each planted tree
5. Name recognition in our volunteer e-mail, which is distributed to over 4,900 people weekly
6. Opportunity to utilize Trees Atlanta Kendeda Center for employee breakfast or lunch event prior to or after planting project (cost of catering to be paid for by company)

Our corporate tree planting projects take approximately 3.5 hours. All participants will receive a brief orientation on Trees Atlanta, the key benefits of trees and proper planting techniques.

Tree Maintenance Project- suggested donation- \$1,500 (available year round)

1. A weekday employee volunteer tree maintenance project for up to 50 participants
2. Publicity photographs taken at event that will appear on the "I Dig Trees" page of the Trees Atlanta website
3. Name recognition in our volunteer e-mail, which is distributed to over 4,900 people weekly
4. Opportunity to utilize Trees Atlanta Kendeda Center for employee breakfast or lunch event prior to or after planting project (cost of catering to be paid for by company)

Our corporate tree maintenance projects take approximately 3 hours, with some flexibility. All participants will receive a brief orientation on Trees Atlanta, the key benefits of trees and the importance of ongoing maintenance for healthy, vibrant trees.
