Trees Atlanta can offer the following trees for front yard planting. These trees need space to grow, about 20' from center from any buildings or power lines. #### Southern Red Oak (*Quercus falcata*)

**HEIGHT**

60 to 80' at maturity

**SPREAD**

60 to 70' at maturity

**LIGHT**

Full sun

**SOIL**

High drought tolerance, poor soil

**FORM**

Round, irregular crown

**ACORN SIZE**

1"



## Willow Oak (*Quercus phellos*)

The willow oak is a stately tree with a delicate leaf and small acorns – a favorite food source of a wide variety of wildlife!

### HEIGHT

60 to 80' at maturity

### SPREAD

30 to 40' at maturity

### LIGHT

Full sun to part shade

### SOIL

Moist, well-drained, acidic

### FORM

Oval-shaped, rounded canopy

### LEAF COLOR

Willow-shaped, finer-textured leaves are earthy green



## Nuttall Oak (*Quercus nuttallii*)

The nuttall oak is fast-growing, low maintenance, and provides ample food and habitat for wildlife.

### HEIGHT

60 to 80' at maturity

### SPREAD

35 to 50' at maturity

### LIGHT

Full sun

### SOIL

Average, well-drained soil

### FORM

Rounded crown

### LEAF COLOR

Dull green; makes small, reddish acorns



Shumard oak (*Quercus shumardii*)

**HEIGHT**

40 to 60' at maturity

**SPREAD**

40 to 60' at maturity

**LIGHT**

Full sun

**SOIL**

Average, loamy soil; can handle some drought

**FORM**

Round

**ACORN SIZE**

1"; leaves turn red in the fall
