



## Trees Atlanta - Georgia Arbor Day Student Art Contest Rules and Submission Guidelines

- All participants must complete this Registration Form to enter:
  - [Arbor Day Art Contest Registration Form](#)
- All Georgia students in grades K-12 (including homeschool students) are eligible to enter.
- Only one submission will be accepted per student.
- Submissions must be original and created by the student.
- Artwork must reflect this year's art contest theme, as [published on our contest website](#) ([www.treesatlanta.org/georgia-arbor-day-student-art-contest-rules](http://www.treesatlanta.org/georgia-arbor-day-student-art-contest-rules))
- Entry must be received by the current year's art contest deadline, as published on the website. Digital submissions are accepted. Physical entries can be mailed or dropped off at Trees Atlanta by the deadline during office hours.
- Artwork must follow these format guidelines:

<b>Acceptable Formats</b>	Drawing, painting, photography, mixed media collage, and sequential art (comics). May be traditional or digital.	Poetry, narrative writing (story), or informational writing (essay). May be handwritten or typed.	Video essay, live action narrative, and animation.

## How to Submit Entry

- **Digital entry:** Upload your file using the online registration form. All digital file submissions must be named according to the guide below:
  - **Last name-First initial-grade-SchoolName**
  - Examples: "Doe-Jane-K-Perkerson" OR "Doe-John-12-SouthAtlantaHS"
- **Mailing Address:** Please be mindful of postal service delivery time and submit mailed entries well in advance of the deadline. Use this mailing address:

## Awards

- Artwork will be reviewed by a panel of Trees Atlanta judges.
- First place, second place, and third place winners will be selected from each age groups:
  - Grades K-2 (age up to 7)
  - Grades 3-5 (age 8-10)
  - Grades 6-8 (age 11-13)
  - Grades 9-12 (age 14 and above)
- Winners will receive a gift card and other contest related prizes.
- Teachers and/or adults who submit art on behalf of the student will receive a gift card to go towards the purchase of educational materials for their student(s).
